December 4, 2001

In the review of the Land Evaluation Criteria discussion arose among the board members evaluating the use of land around the borders. The discussion centered on whether to evaluate by the percent of linear feet that is contiguous with land assessed as farmland or the percentage of contiguous acreage.

A motion was made by Joe Osterman and seconded by Janet Stine to evaluate the land use around the parcel on the percentage of contiguous acres in the adjacent parcels that are assessed as farmland. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Roger Dailey, seconded by Joe Osterman, to approve the Land Evaluation Criteria as revised. The motion passed unanimously.

Maps available from Shepherd College were displayed. No action was taken to purchase copies of these maps.

There was further discussion about the Farmland Protection Plan and the need to finish and approve this document.

With no further business, Joe Osterman moved and Janet Stine seconded that the meeting be adjourned.
